## ABOUT ANTIGUA, GUATEMALA TRIPS



Antigua is known for its cobblestone streets and colonial architecture. The area draws in tourists from all around the world, but there is desperate need hidden just below the beauty of the town. Families living right outside of Antigua struggle to earn enough money for basic food and proper shelter. Children as young as seven frequently give up a chance at education in order to help sustain their family. Partnering with local ministries we will disrupt this cycle of poverty that has a hold on so many Guatemalans. Through construction work, service projects and Children's Bible School, we will invest in the future of the community.
